
The Chief Secretaries to all State Governments,

Subject: - Exemption from undergoing training at LBSNAA, Mussoorie for IAS officers on attaining the age of 52 years under rule 5 (2) of IAS (Probation) Rules, 1954.

I am directed to say that rule 5 (2) of the Indian Administrative Service (Probation) Rules, 1954 envisages mandatory provision for training at Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie for IAS probationer who has not already undergone the training prescribed under sub-regulation (5) of regulation 7 of IAS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955 or sub-regulation (5) of Regulation 3 of the IAS (Appointment by Selection) Regulation, 1956 before such appointment. However, such officer, who has attained the age of 52 years on appointment to the Indian Administrative Service, is exempted from such training in the Academy.

2. In the recent past there have been instances where State Governments have come up with proposals seeking this Department's approval for exemption from undergoing training in respect of IAS officers who have attained 52 years of age on their appointment to the Service. Approval of the Government of India is not required in such cases. It is, therefore, requested that no references in such cases may be made to this Department.
