ORDER

2.2 As per Rule 4 of the IAS (Regulation of Seniority) Rules, 1987, the officers whose names have been mentioned at Sl. No. 2 to 9 of the Select List of 2011 shall be placed below Shri Lokesh Kumar Jatav, the junior most RR IAS officer of 2004 batch and above Shri Rahul Jain, senior most RR IAS officer of Madhya Pradesh Cadre of 2005 batch.

2.3 As per Rule 4 of the IAS (Regulation of Seniority) Rules, 1987, the officers whose names have been mentioned at Sl. No. 10 to 16 of the Select List of 2011 shall be placed below Shri Sanjeev Singh, the junior most RR IAS officer of 2005 batch and above Dr. Khade sudam Pandharinath, senior most RR IAS officer of Madhya Pradesh Cadre of 2006 batch.

2.4 Seniority/year of allotment of officer at Sl. No. 4, 5 & 6 in the Select List of 2011 has been restricted under proviso to Rule 3(3)(ii) of IAS (Regulation of Seniority) Rules, 1987.
