Subject: Promotion of All India Service officers to the
Supertime Scale during their long-term training
clarification regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to say that some references have been received in respect of members of the All India Services who become due for promotion during the period while they are attending a course of long-term training. A question has been raised on whether they could be promoted to higher scale in the normal course with all the intended benefits even while they are on training, in view of the fact that such long term training is treated as duty for all purposes.

2. The matter has been considered and it is hereby clarified that the Supertime and other scales of the IAS which are functional in nature, involve higher duties and responsibilities. The officers concerned would, therefore, be entitled only to the notional benefits of such promotions in terms of increments etc. during the period of their long-term training. The actual benefits of promotion would be admissible to them only when they physically assume charge of a Supertime Scale post on conclusion of their training.

3. However, for the Junior Administrative Grade and Selection Grade which are non-functional, the officer can start drawing the higher scale and other intended benefits from the due date.

4. The above position is brought to the notice of all concerned for dealing with all such cases in future. This position will apply mutatis mutandis to the members of the Indian Police Service and Indian Forest Service also.


