

Minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Kothari, Secretary, DOP&T on 01/12/2015 to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer / extension in inter cadre requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines.

A meeting was held on 01/12/2015 under the Chairmanship of Secretary(P) to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer / extension in inter cadre deputation period requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines. The members of the committee EO & AS and AS(S&V) were also present. Besides Dir(AIS) & US(S-II) were also present to assist the Committee in the meeting.

The Committee took note of the Action Taken Report on the minutes of the previous meeting held on 17/11/2015.

The Committee after detailed deliberations and careful consideration in each case, took following decisions in the meeting:-

Case I: Inter cadre deputation of Shri Lokesh M, IAS (UP:2005) from Uttar Pradesh cadre to Karnataka cadre for a period of 3 years

The Committee was informed that the officer has requested for inter cadre deputation to Karnataka on grounds of taking care of old parents who are residing at Karnataka. Further, the officer is of batch 2005 and has completed the required period of 9 years in his cadre and has not reached supertime scale. **The Committee after detailed deliberations directed to seek comments of Karnataka Government and vigilance status of the officer. Thereafter, on receipt of requisite comments, the proposal along with ACC note may be put up for consideration and approval of ACC.**

Case II: Inter cadre deputation of Shri G.S. Panda Das, IAS (Telangana:2006) from Telangana cadre to Andhra Pradesh cadre.

The Committee was informed that the officer has requested for inter cadre deputation to Andhra Pradesh cadre on the grounds to look after his aged parents. Further, the officer is of 2006 batch and has completed the required period of 9 years in his cadre and has not reached supertime scale. **The Committee after detailed deliberations directed to seek comments of Andhra Pradesh Government and vigilance status of the officer. Thereafter, on receipt of requisite comments, the proposal along with ACC note may be put up for consideration and approval of ACC.**

Case III: Inter cadre deputation of Shri Ranjit Kumar Singh IAS (GJ: 08) from Gujarat cadre to Bihar cadre.

The Committee was informed that the mother of the officer has represented the proposal of inter cadre deputation of the officer. The mother of the officer is on bed rest. The officer is of 2008 batch and has not completed the required 9 years of service in his cadre. **The Committee after detailed deliberations decided to reiterate its earlier decision and did not recommend the proposal of the officer and decided to incorporate the case in the quarterly report to be submitted to ACC and officer to be informed about the above decision.**

Case IV: Cadre change of Shri Vijay Amruta Kulange, IAS (OR:13) on the basis of PH policy dated 14.02.2014

The Committee was informed that all the three preferred states i.e. Gujarat, Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh have regretted / not agreed to the proposal of cadre change of the officer. **The Committee decided to seek the comments of other contiguous states i.e. Chhattisgarh and Telangana and also of the officer with respect to these states.**
