

**Minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Kothari, Secretary, DOP&T on 09.06.2015 at 04:30 P.M to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer/ extension of inter cadre deputation.**

Meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (P) on 09.06.2015 at 04:30 P.M to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer/ extension of inter cadre deputation/ over-stayal on inter cadre deputation. During the meeting, EO & AS(S&V) who is member of the committee was also present. Besides, Dir(AIS) and US(S-II) were also present to assist the Committee in the meeting.

2. At the outset, the Committee reviewed the decision taken on the proposals considered in its last meeting dated 28.05.2015. It was brought to the notice of the Committee that in the cases of Shri Ranjit Kumar Singh, IAS(GJ:08) for inter cadre deputation from Gujarat to Bihar, Shri Rajesh Singh Rana, IAS(CG:08) for inter cadre deputation from Chhattisgarh to AGMUT(Delhi segment), Ms. Jaspreet Kaur, IAS(MN:13) for change of cadre from Manipur to other cadre and Shri Chinmay Pundlikrao Gotmare, IAS(AM:09) for change of cadre from Assam-Meghalaya to either of Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Chhattisgarh or Telangana/inter cadre deputation as interim relief, Committee's decision not to recommend the case have been intimated to the concerned officer. In the cases of Shri Vijay Amruta Kulange, IAS(OR:13) for cadre change from Orissa on the basis of PH policy and Shri Abhishek Singh, IAS(TR:06) for inter cadre deputation from Tripura to Bihar, as per direction of the Committee comments of the respective State Governments have been sought. In the case of Shri Mohan Lal Meena, IAS(MT:01) for inter cadre transfer from Manipur-Tripura on the grounds of threat perception, as decided by the Committee for not to recommend the case of change of cadre to Madhya Pradesh and to explore the possibilities of having Shri Meena on central deputation by waiving of 'cooling off' period, the officer has been informed with a copy to EO division for further action. In the cases of Shri Kuldeep Sharma, IAS(CG:14) from cadre change from Chhattisgarh and Ms. K. Radhika Aiyar, IAS(WB:11) from West Bengal on the basis of PH Policy, it was informed that the Committee's decision to review the PH policy is under preparation, would be put up by 15.06.2015. The proposal in respect of Ms. Swati Srivastava, IAS(CG:12) for inter cadre transfer from Chhattisgarh to Uttarakhand on the ground of marriage has been approved by the Competent Authority and notification has been issued and put on the official website of the Ministry. The work of the Division was appreciated.

3. Thereafter the Committee took up the proposals placed before it one by one and after detailed deliberations and careful consideration in each case, the following decisions have been taken:-

**CASE 1: Ms Kritika Sharma, IAS(WB:14) Inter cadre transfer of Ms Kritika Sharma, IAS(WB:14) from West Bengal cadre to Uttar Pradesh cadre on the grounds of marriage to Shri Abhishek Anand, IAS(UP:14).**

The Committee was informed that the proposal of cadre transfer of Ms Kritika Sharma, IAS(WB:14) from West Bengal to Uttar Pradesh on the grounds of marriage is covered under the rules. The comments of the concerned State Governments have been sought and are awaited. The Committee directed that **after receipt of the comments of both**

the State Governments the proposal may be put up for approval of Secretary(P) through EO & AS.

**CASE 2: Shri Manish Kumar, IAS (BH:05) Inter cadre deputation from Bihar cadre to Uttar Pradesh cadre.**

The Committee was informed that a proposal from Government of Uttar Pradesh for inter cadre deputation of Shri Manish Kumar, IAS(BH:05) from Bihar cadre to Uttar Pradesh cadre for a period of 3 years was received but copy of willingness of the officer for the same has not been received in this Department. The same has been sought. The Committee was also informed that in the meantime the State Government of Bihar had **not agreed** with the proposal stating that there is shortage of AIS officers in the State. Accordingly, the proposal is **not covered** under the policy. The Committee decided **not to recommend the case of the officer** for inter cadre deputation to Uttar Pradesh cadre as the parent cadre of the officer has not agreed for the proposal and directed to **incorporate the case in the quarterly report to be submitted to ACC and the officer to be informed about the above decision.**

**CASE 3: Shri Lalbiakluanga Khiangte, IAS(JH:88) Inter cadre deputation from Jharkhand cadre to AGMUT(Mizoram segment).**

The Committee was informed that a **request from the Government of Mizoram** has been received for inter cadre deputation of Shri Lalbiakluanga Khiangte from Jharkhand cadre to AGMUT (Mizoram segment) due to acute shortage of senior IAS officers in the state. The Committee noted that the officer has **already availed maximum term of home deputation of 5 years. The proposal is not covered under the policy.** The Committee decided **not to recommend the case of the officer** for inter cadre deputation to Uttar Pradesh cadre and directed to **incorporate the case in the quarterly report to be submitted to ACC and the officer to be informed about the above decision.**

**CASE 4: Shri Dheeraj Kumar, IAS(MH:2005) Inter cadre deputation from Maharashtra cadre to Uttar Pradesh cadre.**

The Committee was informed that the State Government of **Maharashtra** had **not given its Consent** to the proposal of inter cadre deputation of Shri Dheeraj Kumar, IAS(MH:2005) from Maharashtra cadre to UP cadre. Accordingly, the proposal is **not covered** under the policy. The Committee decided **not to recommend the case of the officer** for inter cadre deputation to Uttar Pradesh cadre as the parent cadre of the officer has not agreed for the proposal and directed to **incorporate the case in the quarterly report to be submitted to ACC and the officer to be informed about the above decision.**
