

Minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Kothari, Secretary, DOP&T on 17/11/2015 to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer / extension in inter cadre requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines.

A meeting was held on 17/11/2015 under the Chairmanship of Secretary(P) to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer / extension in inter cadre deputation period requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines. The members of the committee EO & AS and AS(S&V) were also present. Besides Dir(AIS) & US(S-III) were also present to assist the Committee in the meeting.

The Committee took note of the Action Taken Report on the minutes of the previous meeting held on 09/11/2015.

The Committee after detailed deliberations and careful consideration in each case, took following decisions in the meeting:-

Case I: Proposal for extension of inter cadre deputation period of Shri Sanjay Kaul, IAS (KL:2001) from Kerala cadre to Gujarat cadre for further 2 years

The Committee was informed that the officer has requested for inter cadre deputation beyond 5 years and NOC from both the State Governments have been received. **The Committee after detailed deliberation decided to defer the proposal.**

CASE II: Inter cadre deputation of Shri Vinod Sharma, IAS (UP:01) from Uttar Pradesh cadre to Uttarakhand cadre.

Case No. III: Inter cadre deputation of Smt Damyanti Dohre, IAS (UP) from Uttar Pradesh cadre to Uttarakhand cadre

For case II & III, the Committee was informed about the present position of the cases. The Committee noted that the officers belong to State Public Service of erstwhile Uttar Pradesh and were allocated to Uttar Pradesh cadre as per the provisions of UP Reorganization Act, 2000 & guidelines framed thereunder. However, the officers continued in Uttarakhand cadre without the approval of the Competent Authority. The Committee after detailed deliberation stated that it is not clear how many officers are continuing in Uttarakhand without approval and how they are continuing in Uttarakhand cadre after getting promotion to IAS from UP quota. Committee recommended to examine such cases in holistic manner so as to avoid occurrence of such situation in future.
