

Minutes of the meeting held under the chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Kothari, Secretary, DOP&T on 31.05.2016 to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer / extension in inter cadre requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines.

A meeting was held on 31.05.2016 under the Chairmanship of Secretary(P) to consider the cases of inter cadre deputation/ inter cadre transfer / extension in inter cadre deputation period requiring relaxation of provision(s) of the guidelines. The members of the committee EO & AS and AS(S&V) were also present. Further, Director, AIS & US (S-III) were also present to assist the Committee in the meeting.

The Committee took note of the Action Taken Report on the minutes of the previous meeting held on 25.05.2016. The Committee after detailed deliberations and careful consideration in each case took following decisions in the meeting:-

Case 1: Request for extension of deputation of Dr. Rathan Kelkar, IAS(KL:2003) from Kerala cadre to Karnataka cadre for a further period of five years.

The Committee was informed that inter cadre deputation of the officer is going to be completed by 18.12.2016 and he has requested for extension for a further period of five years. The Committee was informed that as per policy total allowable period of inter cadre deputation is only five years and therefore he can be allowed extension of deputation for further two year beyond 18.12.2016 after receipt of no-objection/concurrence of both the cadres and vigilance clearance.

The Committee after deliberations directed to seek comments/no-objection from the concerned State Governments and on receipt of the same, put up the proposal along with ACC note for the consideration of the ACC.

The Committee after detailed deliberations on various options placed before it directed to put up the policy on file immediately as per discussion.

Apart from the above, the Committee directed that the cases which are prima-facie covered under the existing policy for inter-cadre transfer/ deputation/extension may immediately be processed as and when received without waiting for placing the same before the Committee. Such proposals may be put up to the Committee after receipt of required no-objection/ documents from the concerned.
