Domestic Funding of Foreign Training (DFFT) Scheme - Introduction of one-year MPA (Mason Programme) conducted by Harvard Kennedy School in 2012-13.

Sir/Madam,

In continuation of this Division's circular of even number dated 16th September 2011 inviting applications for various long/short-term training programmes abroad under the DFFT Scheme, it has since been decided to offer one-year MPA (Mason programme), 2012-13 of the Harvard Kennedy School (HKS) also under the scheme. However, since the deadline for applications for this programme as stipulated by the HKS is 2nd December 2011, a separate application/sponsorship system has been devised so as to align the same with the calendar of HKS for this specific programme. The same is detailed below:

- The interested officers may apply directly to HKS before 2nd December 2011 and undertake (i) admission/selection process as stipulated by HKS as a private individual.
- This Department will earmark three slots for MPA (Mason programme). (ii)
- Once an officer is selected by HKS, he/she may apply for sponsorship under the DFFT Scheme (iii) through their respective controlling authorities along with requisite clearances, e.g., vigilance clearance, ACR Grading, etc.
- Applications of such officers will be considered by a Committee to be constituted in DOPT. (iv)
- The successful applicants will receive full funding as in the case of other long-term programmes. (v)
- The eligibility criteria for applying for Mason Programme will be same as mentioned in our 2. circular dated 16th September 2011 in respect of other long-term training programmes.
